First Session:

President Mary Smith called the meeting to order at 9:15.

Father Luiz Dutra said a prayer.

Max Ray led the Pledge of Allegiance.

All Board Members are present: President Mary Smith, Vice President Max Ray, Acting Secretary Medford Magill, Treasurer Houston Moss, Senior Board Member Lenora Heinen, Middle Board Member Oliver Childress, and Junior Board Member Lisa Blakeney. **Town Representatives:** Alexandria Chapter - Robert Southwell, Baton Rouge Chapter - Huey Barbin, and Lafayette Chapter - Cleve Cormier.

Lenora Heinen welcomed the 39th LAD Convention. She presented the event of plans for the weekend.

President Smith introduced two official interpreters for Friday and Saturday. They are Linda Ducote and Geri Garcile.

President Smith requested for approval of 1993 Convention Minutes. Max moved that we accept the 1993 Convention minutes with the exception of the unfinished business. Passed.

President's Report:

(President's report was held up due to a telephone call needs her respond at this moment.)

Vice President's Report:

Vice Pres. Max Ray presented a greeting and complimented on the board members and LAD members for working together and keep LAD standing strong. **See attached (A)**

Important Persons in Audience:

President Smith introduced VIP person(s) in the audience. Rosland Harris of Louisiana Rehabilitation Service and a commissioner on Louisiana Commission for the Deaf. Her role is provide rehabilitation service to the deaf and hearing impaired.

Mary introduced Leo Burke, our former secretary and Executive Director of Deaf Action Center (DAC) of Baton Rouge). Statements from Leo Burke.. Thank you members and friends. I was secretary of LAD, I enjoyed my job but many things popped up which force me to quit my job. My heart is still with LAD whether I am still here or not. Mary complimented on his kindness with words.

- 95-021 M. Smith () add to Article VI - Standing Committees Section 9 on page 28 as special standing committees (9) Deaf Education Advocacy Committee. Canceled
- 95-022 Burke (Huey Barbin) move that the sympo account be independent with its own Federal Tax I.D. Motion carried.
- 95-023 R. Delvisco (Ed Wood) move that we use the principles and proceeds of the Merrill Lynch account for our purchase of a home office (building) only effective after this convention. Joe Broussard (J. Falcon) move to change the word "use" to "set aside". Amendment approved. R. Sheffield (A. Gremillion) amend that the president establish a committee to begin looking for a building. Amendment approved. Amended motion carried.
- 95-024 M. Smith (M. Magill) Add to page 19, line 26: The president shall have the authority to transact all business on a daily basis during intervals between regular Board of Directors meetings. B. Bevill (D. Fontenot) move to add a limit of \$500 for each decision. Houston Moss (R. Southwell) amends that treasurer must be consulted about these daily decisions. Amendments approved. Amended motion carried.
- 95-025 H. Barbin (R. Southwell) move that the LAD President performs as the Ex. Dir. in absentia until the hiring of the Ex. Dir. and its funding is feasible. Motion carried.
- 95-026 Melvin (Lenora) move that LAD should sponsor symposium annually following after convention. Canceled
- 95-027 Delvin Fontenot (B. Broussard) move that any bid for the convention will have a free Buffet Breakfast provided by LAD. Motion denied.
- 95-028 H. Moss (H. Barbin) move that the LAD Scholarship for \$500 for the 1993 Miss Deaf LA, Meg Gardner, be converted to a donation to pay for her books, supplies, etc. Motion carried.
- 95-029 R. Sheffield (Lisa Blakeney) move that treasure make copy - one for office and one for home. Motion denied.
- 98-030 R. Sheffield (H. Barbin) moves to reconsider 95-017. Motion denied.

Treasurer Moss mentioned that Acting Secretary Magill should take his place because he spoke a portion about LAD Treasurer report. He said that 1993 Financial Report is in the Program Book and 1994 Financial Report is on the table. 1993 Financial report is printed on page 15 of the Program Book. 1994 Financial report is on the table for you to pick up. **See attached (C)**

Treasurer Houston Moss requested for someone to make a motion to have Louisiana Symposium account separated under its own Federal Identification.

Auditors:

Oliver Childress, Chief Auditor and his auditing committee audited and approved the Treasurer's books.

Junior Board Member's Report:

Lisa Blakeney spoke about her learning experience with LAD for the past two years. It was a great learning experience working with LAD officers. She was a co-chairperson for the NAD Region III convention in New Orleans working with Oliver Childress. The convention was very successful.

She is working on the LAD cookbook project. she asked everyone to send her your recipes and would like to have 500 or more recipes for the cookbook project. She will be the judge for the LAD pageant tonight. She is looking forward to it.

President Mary Smith spoke briefly about her role on Early Identification for Hearing Impaired Infants Advisory Council.

Alexandria Chapter Representative:

Robert Southwell announced that Alexandria Association of the Deaf doesn't want to bid for the 1997 Convention.

Baton Rouge Chapter Representative:

Huey Barbin said on Behalf of BRAD, I want to congratulate LAAD for hosting this convention. Two years ago BRAD talked about buying property and merge with LAD. BRAD bought two buildings with attach property. The estate is paid for. BRAD will resume on conducting Bingo games at a new place at 4-H hall by July 1st. BRAD will have events for 4th of July, and Labor Day. We will have a big dance at its hall the evening of LSD Homecoming day Oct 28th, LSD vs MSD.

Huey Barbin spoke about his experience as a board member and how LAD has progress in the last two years.

Lafayette Chapter Representative:

Cleve Cormier talked how successfull their Bingo has been lately. LAAD is waiting for the right time and decision to have their (LAAD) clubhouse built.

Recess: President Smith requested 15 minute break. Recess at 10:25. Resume at 10:40.

The meeting was resumed at 10:48 a.m.

President's Report:

President Mary Smith want to thank the host, committees, members and visitors for being at the Convention. **See attached E**

Assistant Pageant Director:

Bambi Pippins announced that there is a pageant tonight at 7:00 p.m. and they are selling World's Finest Chocolate with almonds for \$1.00.

Awards Committee:

Elise Broussard requested that the candidates for Award forms be mailed to the members at a sufficient timeframe to give them time to fill out the forms and to mail the forms back to LAD Award Committee.

Publication Committee:

President Smith admitted that BSB was one of the weakness in advertising.

President Smith announced that Cindy Frederick sent her a Thank You card for sending her to Boston, Mass. She expressed her gratitude for attending to the Deaf Study IV.

Bingo Chairman Report:

Ronnie Delvisco said that LAD face a bad violation of gaming ordinance of the city. Bingo funds are decreasing. It took 2 months of search and plan to relocate. Bingo revenue is increasing very slowly. If you want to retain Consultant Earl Wilson our renvenues will run out within three months. The decision is up to you. He wants to turn over his position as Bingo Chair to someone else and assist to train the person. He mentioned that Treasurer Moss said that general funds (G.F.) is not in good hands because Bingo revenues are gaining very slow to keep up with the consultant fees. The consultatn's fees are expensive and will wipe out Bingo revenues.

Law Committee Report:

Max Ray, chair gave handouts of Referrals & Proposals. Lets start with Referrals from the 38th Convention.

#93-001: D. Fontenot (R. Southwell) moved that the President of LAD appoint three out-of-town LAD members who do not hold any LAD office to audit the LAD financial reports with their travel expenses being paid by LAD; effective immediately after this convention. (By-Laws: Article VI, page 26)

The Motion was referred to Law Committee. This committee rejected this due to high costs as to the number of audits between conventions--See **93-005** for such improvement!

Robert Southwell (Danny Arabie) amend to audit only once 30 days prior to the convention. **Carried**

The amend motion to #93-001 is **approved**.

#93-003 C. Tullos (C. Greenlee) moved that the Deaf Louisiana Pageant be held during the 1995 LAD Convention and thereafter at every convention.

The Motion was referred to Law Committee for review. This committee agreed that this is already adopted into the already-approved guidelines by the LAD Board of Directors in Lafayette on March 11, 1995 and adopted #93-008 entirely which stated: "The LAD shall host the Miss Deaf Louisiana Pageant during conventions."

approved the Committee's recommendation.

#93-004 R. Delvisco (L. Burke) moved that "Any of the standing committees or Ad-Hoc committees that receive any property and/or funds from LAD, whether independent or not, shall make a complete report to the LAD Board of Directors and abide by the By-Laws of LAD, effective immediately.

The Motion was referred to Law Committee for proper placement in the By-Laws booklet as was adopted. The Law Committee determined that a new sub-section is added to Article VI as Section 13: Properties/or Funds received by Committees: on page 29, line 5. **Approved** the Committee's recommendation.

#93-005 Bobbie LeFors (Houston Moss) moved that the treasury books be audited several times between the conventions by the Auditing Committee.

The motion was referred to the Law Committee for review. The Law committee recommended that this can be done during the time of each Board of Directors meeting in order to save such expenses on the traveling costs by the members of the Auditing Committee.

H. Moss (R. Malcolm) amend to change the wording "several times" to "once every month". **Carried**

M. Smith (R. Malcolm) amend to change the capital A to a small a "Auditing" to "auditing". **Carried**

SESSION II

The amended motion of #93-005. "B. LeFors (H. Moss) moved that the treasury books be audited once every month between the conventions by the auditing committee." **Carried**

Recess for lunch at 12:05 p.m. til 1:00 p.m.

The business meeting is resumed at 1:30 p.m.

Continue discussing the Law Committee report, Chair by Max Ray.

#93-006 L. Blakeney (M. Smith) moved that an amendment being made on Article II, Section 1 (page 11) as inserting "resident of the state of Louisiana" after the word "deaf/hard of hearing"...

The motion was referred to Law Committee for proper modification as it was adopted. The Law Committee already added this to the By-Laws booklet and will have up-to-dated By-Law books printed by 1996 (Look at page 40).

approved the Committee's recommendation.

#93-007 H. Gremillion (P. Wood) moved that the LAD Board of Directors and Pageant Committee implement together such guideline and policies operating the Miss Deaf Louisiana Pageant and the said guidelines include what LAD will give Miss Deaf Louisiana during her reign. M. Ray (L. Burke) amended that this is to be referred to the Pageant committee along with two members of the LAD Board of Directors.

The Motion was referred to Law Committee for modification after both materials were reviewed by the Board. In the near future, there will be a study on policies by the same committee members
Carried

#93-014: J. Falcon (E. David) moved to abolish LAD restrictions imposed upon LRID Representative on the LAD Board. The recent proposal No. 2 during the 1993 Convention was passed as read: "The LRID Representative must be a member of the Louisiana Association of the Deaf and must be certified by the Louisiana Commission for the Deaf with the said skills based on the fourth level or higher." This was to be added to Article III, Section 3: Other Board Members, a) LRID Representative:.. on page 18.

The motion was referred back to Law Committee for clarification. The committee rejects this motion due to the fact that our restrictions are truly equivalent to the same requirements set up by LRID upon LAD Representative.

Approved the committee's recommendation.

#93-016 L. Burke (R. Massie) moved to delete Article III, Section 3:a- "LRID Representative to LAD and also delete "President shall represent LAD as the LAD Representative to the LRID."

The motion was referred to Law Committee for review. This Committee recommends strongly that those sections are to be left alone until further study upon the relations between LAD and LRID for a while. Therefore the referred motion is rejected!! **Carried**

#93-026: L. Burke (R. Sheffield) moved that the entire section of Article VII, Section 4: Any By-Law Being Waived: "Any By-Law may be waived temporarily by two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members present. No vote is needed to reinstate" be transferred from reaching Section 5.

The motion was referred to Law Committee for review. This Committee agrees with this motion so it is not necessary for any action.

This action is **rejected** by the LAD members.

NEW Proposals: Proposals 95-001 to 95 009 are recommended by the Law Committee.

95-001: Add a new section under ARTICLE I: MEMBERSHIP:

SECTION 5: PROFESSIONAL MEMBERSHIP

Any bona-fide professional organization or agency may become a Professional Affiliate Membership upon payment of a professional affiliate fee annually as determined by the LAD Board of Directors.

Law Committee supports this proposal entirely. LAD members favors it. **Carried**

95-002: Add a new section under ARTICLE I: MEMBERSHIP:

SECTION 6: ORGANIZATIONS OF THE DEAF AFFILIATES

Any organization of the Deaf in the state of Louisiana may become an Affiliate Member upon payment of an affiliate fee annually as determined by the LAD Board of Directors.

Law Committee supports this proposal entirely. LAD members

Joe Broussard (R. Malcolm) amend to change the word "annually" to "bi-annually". **Failed**

Vote on the main motion, #95-002. **Carreid**

95-003 Add a new section under ARTICLE I: MEMBERSHIP:

SECTION 7: SENIOR CITIZENS

Senior Citizen status may be requested by a member of LAD at the age of 63 with no change of status or privilege. Senior Citizen dues shall be determined by the LAD Board of Directors.

Law Committee supports this proposal as a whole.

Leo Burke (J. Falcon) amend to add the wording Deaf/Hard of Hearing. SECTION 7: DEAF/HARD OF HEARING SENIOR CITIZENS. **Failed**

Ed Wood (R. Southwell) amend to change the age from 63 to 60. **Carried**

LAD members voted to favor with amended motion. **Carried**

95-004 Add a new section under ARTICLE I: MEMBERSHIP:

SECTION 8: STUDENT MEMBERS

Full-time deaf/hard of hearing student at elementary, secondary, post-secondary or collegiate programs may become members of the Louisiana Association of the Deaf at one-half regular member dues.

Law Committee supports this proposal entirely.

Joe Broussard (R. Malcolm) amend to add the word student to the first line of the paragraph. **Carried.**

Mary Smith (M. Magill) amend to add "without the right to vote or hold office" at the last paragraph. **Failed.**

H. Moss (D. Abadie) amend that any post-graduate or college students have voting rights. (Make it as a new paragraph). **Carried.**

LAD members voted to favor the whole **95-004** motion as amended. **Carried.**

95-005 Add a new section under ARTICLE III: DUTIES OF OFFICERS (page 19, line 16)

SECTION 6: LEGAL ASSISTANCE BY MEMBER OR OFFICER

Any member or officer of LAD who use legal assistance without prior approval by the Board of Directors shall pay the legal fees out of his/her pocket.

Law Committee supports this proposal as a whole.

LAD members voted to favor this motion. **Carried.**

95-006 Add a new section to ARTICLE VIII: FINANCES (Page 33, line 4):

SECTION 9: CONTRIBUTION/FLOWERS TO DECEASED PAST OR
PRESENT OFFICERS

Any contribution or flowers may be sent to the deceased past or present officers of LAD under instructions by the President of LAD with a minimum of forty dollars (\$40.00) and not to exceed seventy-five dollars (\$75.00).

Law Committee favors this proposal with thumbs up.

J. Falcon (Ed Wood) amend to strike the wording "or flowers".
Failed

LAD members voted to favor this 95-006 motion. **Carried**

95-007 Add a new sub-section to D: TREASURER under ARTICLE III: OFFICERS OF SECTION 2: OFFICERS AND DUTIES (page 17)
CARRIED.

95-008 Add a new sentence to ARTICLE VIII: FINANCES, Section 1: FEES (page 30, line 7)

After the first sentence, insert a new sentence: "All annually dues of the affiliates and professional memberships already classified in the said article shall be determined by the LAD Board of Directors and also applies to the biannually dues and fees."
Carried

95-009 To delete the entire section of ARTICLE II: OFFICERS: SECTION 1: QUALIFICATIONS FOR CANDIDATES and insert a new section on (page 11):

SECTION 1: QUALIFICATIONS FOR CANDIDATES

Any Candidate run for office must be deaf/hard of hearing, a resident of the state of Louisiana, must be a member in good standing. The candidate must be in attendance at the present convention.

Law Committee feels that this proposal would allow a person to be a member for the first time and run for any office with little or no background of the LAD's accomplishments, programs, and lack of knowledge of the LAD Constitution and By-Laws and determines that this proposal is dangerous to the LAD as well as not in the best interest of our LAD!

LAD members favors the motion regardless of Law Committee's expression. **Carried**

Introduction of a Political candidate for Lt. Governor.

President Mary Smith introduce Kathleen Blanco who is running for LT. Governor and happened to show up. Kathleen Blanco spoke briefly to the audience and will be very proud to have your vote. M. Magill and H. Barbin spoke highly of Kathleen Blanco, Public Service Commissioner Chairlady. Also introduced Merilyn Istre, Blanco's assistant and is the President of Relay Administration Board.

Recess: President Smith called for a 10 minute break.

Meeting resumed at 3:28 p.m.

Ways and Means Committee Report: Houston Moss shows a transparency of the scale system of the BINGO revenue established since 1989 to 1994, a transparency of the INVESTED funds of LAD from 1990 to 1995,

Treasurer Houston Moss shows a transparency of ASSETS growth of LAD from 1990 - \$372,473.20 to 1995 - \$434,595.48, shows a transparency of proposed LAD BUDGET for 1994, 1995, AND 1996 and shows a transparency of proposed LAD Budget for 1997.

Ways and Means committee revised the budget from \$88,000 to \$67,000 for 1996. Jack Falcon (M. Royer) moved to accept the Ways and Means Committee's proposal. **Carried**

May Ray (Joe Broussard) moved to accept Ways and Means Committee's budget proposal for 1997. **Carried**

Consultant Report: Earl Wilson shared the information about what he did for LAD and who paid him a total of approximately \$91,000.00 in 3 1/2 years.

The meeting terminated at 4:30 p.m.

Recess until tomorrow morning at 10:00 a.m.

Old Business:

A Motion proposed by Cathy Corbett at the 93 Convention stating that LAD support LCD task force on an outdoor camp for the deaf. It was referred to Ways and Means committee discuss oon this. No action was taken by the W/M committee.

Proposal recommending LAD to bid on hosting NAD convention in New Orleans in the year 2000. Hosting jointly by Metro New Orleans Association of the Deaf, Lafayette Athletic Association of the Deaf, Baton Rouge Association of the Deaf and LAD. Informed that NAD has to take turns by regions and already has convention host for three years ahead. We must wait until they are taking bids in our region again.

For information: Coverage for special Events LAD is covered by Henry Insurance for \$399.
We are protected for \$1 million.

- 95-011 Motion by Ronnie Delvisco (Jack Falcon) that LAD President to ask appropriate agencies to help LAD defray the expenses for the LAD consultant. Motion **carried**
- 95-012 Ronnie Delvisco (A. Patterson) move to increase pageant budget from \$1000 to \$5000 for 1996-97. Motion **carried**
- The motion referred to Ways and Means committee for budget maintenance.
- 95-013 J. Broussard (M. Ray) move that a discretionary fund of \$1000 be established for usage of travel expenses necessary for attendances to a city or state conference/symposium/workshop/lecture within LA requiring participation of a Board representative or his/her designee of LAD. This fund will be maintained by the President. Amount amended to \$2000. Amended motion **Carried**
- 95-014 J. Broussard (M. Ray) move that LAD is to reconsider on Proposal # 95-006 Section 9 - contribution/flowers to deceased past or present officers. "Any contribution or flowers may be sent to the deceased past or present officers of the LAD under instruction by the President of the LAD. Flowers will be sent with a minimum of \$40 and not to exceed \$75." A contribution will be a fixed amount of \$50. Motion **Carried** Motion #95-006 Section 9 was amended per this request. This motion was **Carried**.
- 95-015 Robert Southwell (D. Fontenot) move that LAD official delegates to NAD convention should be limited to two delegates. Motion **carried**.
- 95-016 Mary Smith (M. Ray) move to add to Article III (Duties of Officers) Section A: President - to conduct all media interviews representing LAD as its sole spokesperson unless otherwise assigned. Motion **carried**.
- 95-017 Mary Smith (M. Magill) move to add to Article III - Duties of Officers Section 2 D: Treasurer - to see that all original books must be kept in a fire-proof file cabinet under lock and key at Home office of LAD.

Amend: Falcon (B. Hainkel) Treasurer make copies of originals at the office to take home for his records and he can work on these copies at home and bring them to the office and place new work in the originals.
